(Overview of responses--How to make our schools better)--Respondents would like:

- Music lessons offered (perhaps after school) at the Coombs School and starting in grade 3 at the Quashnet School
- World Languages offered (perhaps after school) at the Coombs School and the Quashnet School
- Broader selection of world languages at MMHS--perhaps add Latin, American Sign Language, German, etc.)
- More staff training to support students who have social/emotional challenges
- Parenting Classes (Behavior, Nutrition, HW Help, Social Media, Safety, Wellness, etc.)
- Field Trips at every grade level ("real")
- A "Life-101" course offering for all students (technology, nutrition, financial literacy, executive functioning skills, living responsibly, etc.)
- MMHS students to serve as mentors for special needs children
- MMHS Career Fair to be continued and expanded for students in grades 9 - 12
- AP, SAT, ACT prep/study sessions
- More challenging learning opportunities for advanced students--all schools; make higher-level classes available
- HW Help Clubs; Tutoring
- Parent-Teacher Conferences--more than 1x/year
- MMHS field trips outside of the United States
- Police presence in all schools
- Improved school security--main entrances
- More staff diversity
- More cultural education
- More vocational learning opportunities at MMHS
- Smaller class sizes at the middle school
- Movement breaks throughout the school day/increased physical activity
- Longer days for Pre-K and bus transportation
- Increased communication from middle school
