

## Mashpee Public Schools Update 9-3-20

- Linked here is the District's <u>COVID-19 Addendum</u> to each school's 20-21 Parent/Student Handbook. Please take some time to read the important information contained in this document.
- Letters are being mailed tomorrow morning to the families of all PreK to Grade 6 students indicating the student's homeroom assignment, the cohort to which he/she has been assigned (Grades 4 6), the learning model selected by the parents/guardians, and the transportation decision made by the family. Due to the complexity of the various learning models in place for this school year, student placement is unable to be changed.
- MMHS students (Grades 7 12) will be able to log into PowerSchool later this evening to find out the cohort (Mashpee or Falcons) to which they have been assigned. Each student will see either a Mashpee "M" icon if he/she is assigned to the Mashpee cohort or a flying falcon icon if he/she is assigned to the Falcons cohort. If a student is a 100% remote learner, in addition to the assigned cohort icon, he/she will also see a blue "RL" to indicate that he/she is a remote learner. Class schedules should be finalized and available to students by Wednesday, September 9th.
- Students entering kindergarten and students who are new to the Coombs School may call the school's main office at 508-539-1520 to schedule a tour prior to the start of the school year (September 16th for first and second graders and September 17th for preschoolers and kindergarteners). All visitors will be required to wear masks and follow other safety guidelines.
- Third Grade Step-Up visits at the Quashnet School are scheduled for next week: Tuesday, 9/8, Wednesday, 9/9, and Thursday, 9/10, from 4 - 6 PM on each day. Families will be receiving a communication from Principal O'Brien with directions on how to select a day and time for your visit. All visitors will be required to wear masks and follow other safety guidelines.
- Seventh Grade Step-Up visits at the Mashpee Middle-High School are scheduled for next week as well: Wednesday, 9/9, and Thursday, 9/10, from 4:00 6:30 PM on each day. A <u>FLYER</u> was sent home yesterday to all families of 7th graders with event details and directions for scheduling your visit. All visitors will be required to wear masks and follow other safety guidelines.
- All schools are closed Friday, September 4th through Monday, September 7th.
