We can't believe how quickly the summer of 2017 is sailing by. Bright and early on Tuesday, September 5th, our amazing first through twelfth grade students will return. We are looking forward to the 2017-2018 academic year with great enthusiasm and optimism. Our planning has been collaborative, strategic, and student-centered.

All Mashpee Public School employees will be returning on August 29th for three professional days. We still have a few positions yet to be filled.

We are very grateful to the DPW for all the improvements that have been made to our facilities during the summer. All interior lighting at the Quashnet School and the Coombs School has been changed to LED. Interior painting has been done at all three schools. New carpet has been installed in various locations. A new playground is in place at the Quashnet School. The Mashpee Middle-High School gymnasium floor has been refurbished and new tennis courts and basketball courts are nearing completion. Planning and scheduling meetings continue to take place on the Quashnet roof/window/door project which we expect to begin next April. Through a partnership with Mashpee TV and with the help of the DPW, an area off the Mashpee Middle-High School library is being renovated and outfitted for a TV studio and control room. A LEGO wall is scheduled to go into the Quashnet library. Flag poles at the Coombs School are scheduled for painting, and directional arrows in the Coombs parking lot are being redone to accommodate planned changes in the traffic flow for busses and parent drop-offs/pick-ups.

This year we will be building a community coalition. Members of this group will meet quarterly to learn more about what is happening in our school district, to celebrate and share in student and staff successes, and to plan for improvement and growth. We are looking for a broad representation from within the Mashpee community--business owners, directors of non-profit organizations, religious leaders, and more.
